<ul> <li>January</li> <li>* Do Pruning on trees and shrubs, use pruning sealer to treat cuts.</li> <li>* Time to use Ferti-Lome Scalecide Dormant Oil Spray on trees and shrubs.</li> <li>* Start planting grape and berry vines now through March.</li> </ul>	February② * Use Ferti-Lome Weed & Feed with Dimension if you haven't already.* Time to treat all trees and shrubs for borers and insects with Ferti-Lome Tree & Shrub Drench.
