<div>January</div> <div><div>* Do Pruning on trees and shrubs, use pruning sealer to treat cuts.</div><div>* Time to use Ferti-Lome Scalecide Dormant Oil Spray on trees and shrubs.</div><div>* Start planting grape and berry vines now through March.</div></div>	<div>February</div> <div><div>② * Use Ferti-Lome Weed & Feed with Dimension if you haven’t already.</div><div>* Time to treat all trees and shrubs for borers and insects with Ferti-Lome Tree & Shrub Drench. (Last for 12 months)</div><div>* Time to plant seed potatoes, onions and cool season garden plants.</div><div>* In third week—Time to feed pecan & fruit trees with Ferti-Lome Cirtus & Pecan Food.</div></div>	<div>March</div> <div><div>① * Time to apply Ferti-Lome A-Vert plus Lawn Food, gives up to six months control on broadleaf weed seeds.</div><div>* Start feeding roses and blooming shrubs monthly with Ferti-Lome Rose Food with Systemic Insecticide.</div><div>* Treat fruit trees with Ferti-Lome Fruit Tree Spray to help prevent diseases and insects problems.</div></div>
<div>April</div> <div><div>* Work garden soil and fertilize with Ferti-Lome Gardeners Special.</div><div>* Plant tomatoes, peppers, and seeds for spring vegetable gardens.</div><div>* Apply application of Ferti-Lome Tree and Shrub Food.</div><div>* Watch for insects and fungus on all plants - Spray as needed.</div><div>* Work color beds and plant Spring and Summer color.</div></div>	<div>May</div> <div><div>② * Time to apply Ferti-Lome Weed & Feed with Dimension to stop weed seed germination.</div><div>* Rose fungus is normally bad in May - Watch for Black Spot & Powdery Mildew, treat with Ferti-Lome Systemic Fungicide.</div><div>*Fertilize garden and flowering plants with Ferti-Lome fertilizers to ensure a bountiful harvest of fruit and flowers.</div></div>	<div>June</div> <div><div>① * Apply Ferti-Lome Southwest Green Maker fertilizer to lawn.</div><div>* Last month to feed pecan trees - use Ferti-Lome Citrus and Pecan Tree Food.</div><div>* Time to plant Bermuda grass seed in sunny lawn areas to thicken and fill in bare spots.</div><div>* Use Ferti-Lome Weed-Out to rid lawn of broadleaf weeds.</div></div>
<div>July</div> <div><div>* Treat lawns for grubs, fleas, ticks and other insects with Hi-Yield Kill-A-Bug II granules or spray.</div><div>Start working gardens for planting fall cool weather vegetables.</div><div>* Treat potted plants for insects.</div></div>	<div>August</div> <div><div>② * Continue to use Ferti-Lome Weed & Feed with Dimension to stop weed seed germination.</div><div>* Great time to apply Natures Guide Soil Activator to your lawn to breakdown thatch and add nutrients.</div><div>* Excellent time to clean up bermuda grass lawn weeds with Ferti-Lome Weed-Out with Q.</div></div>	<div>September</div> <div><div>① * Apply Ferti-Lome A-Vert plus Lawn Food for a head start on winter weed control.</div><div>* Fertilize trees and shrubs with Ferti-Lome Tree and Shrub Food.</div><div>* Work flower beds and plant mums for fall color.</div><div>* Inspect trees and shrubs for insect damage, fungus or disease.</div></div>
<div>October</div> <div><div>* Need to start treating outdoor potted plants for insect control to bring in for winter.</div><div>* Clean-up weeds in flower beds getting ready to winterize with mulch.</div><div>* Time to plant cool season color - Pansies and Kale etc.</div><div>* Start working gardens for planting cool weather vegetables.</div></div>	<div>November</div> <div><div>①② * Time to apply Ferti-Lome Winterizer with Weed Preventer.</div><div>* Time to prepare your bulb beds for spring bulbs.</div><div>* Need to mulch your shrub beds and get ready for winter.</div><div>* Bring in all tender plants you want to save over the winter.</div><div>* Perfect time to plan for planting new trees and shrubs.</div></div>	<div>December</div> <div><div>* Start planting fruit trees, shade trees, and shrubs now through May - plant with Garden World Nursery Mix and Ferti-Lome Root Stimulator.</div><div>* Time to select that perfect cut Christmas tree.</div><div>* Visit our Christmas shop for those special ornaments and decorations.</div><div>* From Garden World: Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year.</div></div>
